I have also the honour to inform the House that Governor has been pleased to appoint Rana Kanwarpal Singh , M.L.A , in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by virtue of clause (1) of Article 180 of the Constitution of India, to perform the duties of the office of the Speaker of the Fifteenth Punjab Vidhan Sabha, till the election of the Speaker is held under Article 178."

(Then, Rana Kanwarpal Singh occupied the Chair as Pro-tem Speaker.)

2. <u>Announcement by the Secretary</u>

The Secretary made the following announcement :-

"Before I request the Hon'ble Members for taking oath, I beg to lay on the table of the House, a copy of the notification issued on 14th March, 2017 by the Chief Election Commission of India showing the names of the Members of the fifteenth Punjab Vidhan Sabha duly elected in the General Elections of 2017." 3.

Oath or Affirmation by the Members

The Hon'ble Members were administered oath, one by one, in the following order :-

- Leader of the House, Chief Minister 1.
- Cabinet Ministers 2.
- State Ministers 3.
- Leader of the Opposition 4.
- Lady Members 5
- Remaining Members, District -wise 6.

In all 114 members took oath, out of them 111 Members in Punjabi, 1 Member in Hindi and 2 Members took oath in English.

The House, then, adjourned till 02.00 P.M on Monday, the 27th March, 2017.
