6. Motion under Rule 16

The following motion moved by the Chief Minister was put to the vote of the House and carried unanimously:

7. <u>Motion regarding Constitution of the Elected Committees for the year</u> 2022-23

The following motion moved by the Chief Minister was carried unanimously: "Whereas the elections to the-

- i. Committee on Public Accounts;
- ii. Committee on Estimates;

iii. Committee on Public Undertakings; and

iv. Committee on Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes for the year 2022-23, are to be held before the 31st March, 2022; and

WHEREAS the time left at the disposal of the House is extremely short and it is not possible to conduct in the normal course, the election to these Committees;

Now, therefore, this House authorizes the Speaker, Punjab Vidhan Sabha to nominate the Members of the aforesaid Committees for the aforesaid year, keeping in view the proportionate strength of various Parties/Groups in the House;

This House further resolves that for the above purpose, the rules of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Punjab Vidhan Sabha (Punjab Legislative Assembly) relating to the elections to the said Committees for the year 2022-23 which are inconsistent with or contrary to the above resolution shall stand suspended."

8. <u>With regard to holding Motion of Thanks and Discussion on</u> Governor's Address in the next session

As per the consent of the House, it was decided to hold motion of thanks and discussion on the Hon'ble Governor's address in the next session.

9. Official Resolution

The following motion moved by the Chief Minister was unanimously carried as amended:

Sardar Bhagat Singh laid down his life by kissing the gallow ropes for the freedom of the country and his martyrdom set such a spark amongst the people of India that the Britishers were forced to set free the Country. Every youth and inhabitant of the Punjab considers Shaheed Bhagat Singh as his role model. It is our duty to do something for him.

Apart from this, after the independence of the country when the constitution of our Country was being written, Dr.B.R.Ambedkar (Baba Sahib Ambedkar) had made a great contribution in writing the constitution. That is why he is also called the architect of the constitution. Such a great personality should always be remembered and we should take guidance from his life.

Hence, this House strongly recommends to the State Government that an appropriate action be taken to install the statues of Shaheed Bhagat Singh Ji, Dr.Ambedkar Ji and Maharaja Ranjit Singh Ji in the Punjab Vidhan Sabha so that the representatives of the people can take guidance from them and can serve the Country with selfless spirit.
